Start with a pilot on one span and expand to the entire structure without redesigning your network: the same xDAS® architecture supports **dozens to hundreds of channels** with sub-ms timing and Store&Forward® resilience.

Whether your site favors **Ethernet, Wi-Fi, DigiMESH® or GSM,** the system adapts; when links drop, recording continues locally and auto-backfills to the core. Engineers see **clean, comparable datasets** across seasons and events, enabling true trending rather than one-off measurements.

From day one, you get actionable views—spectra, trends and OMA results—so owners and authorities can align on evidence, set **confident thresholds**, and plan maintenance with fewer lane closures. It's the same workflow across all bridge types, from long-span cable systems to segmental and heritage structures—**modular**, **rugged**, **and future-proof**.

Sentry System® is Digitex Systems' end-to-end platform for Structural Health Monitoring. It digitizes at the sensor, time-synchronizes every channel (GPS/DigiSync®), and moves data reliably over Ethernet, Wi-Fi, DigiMESH®, or GSM/4G to a central xPlorer unit running Voyager®. This architecture eliminates analog noise and drift, keeps channels phase-aligned for serious analytics (spectra, modal, trending), and scales from pilots to large multi-asset networks.

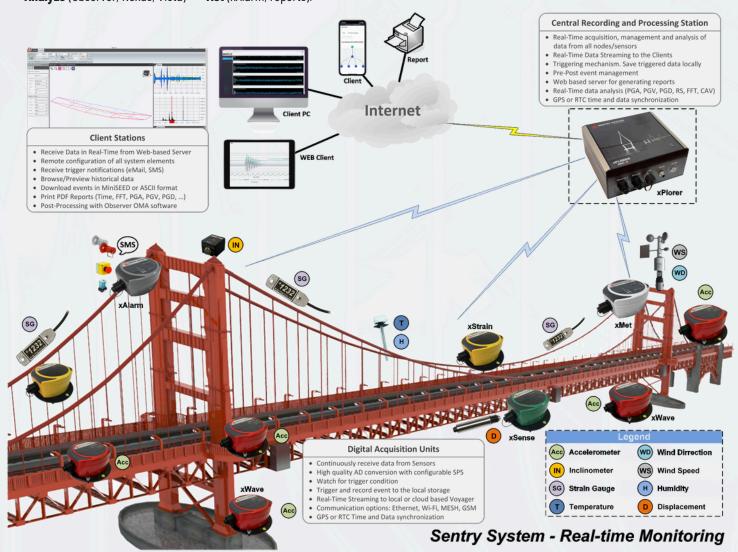
Each edge device records locally with Store&Forward® to survive link outages and auto-backfills the moment connectivity returns. Operators and engineers work in a single workspace: configuring devices, watching real-time streams, setting thresholds and alarms, and exporting reports. With Observer for OMA, Nexus for redundant streaming, Vista for viewing, and xAlarm for notifications, Sentry turns raw measurements into decisions—day-to-day and post-event.
