Voyager® (running on xPlorer or in the cloud) acquires, manages, and analyzes data from diverse sensors, supports manual and event-driven triggers with pre-/post-buffers, and provides automatic PDF reports for each event. The system's multi-threaded core broadcasts live measurements to remote locations while also recording locally for resilience; users can retrieve data locally or remotely, receive email notifications, and FTP-upload events. With 24/32-bit conversion, bursts to 1,000 sps, and broad sensor compatibility, xCAS delivers accurate structural response monitoring from a single, centralized platform.

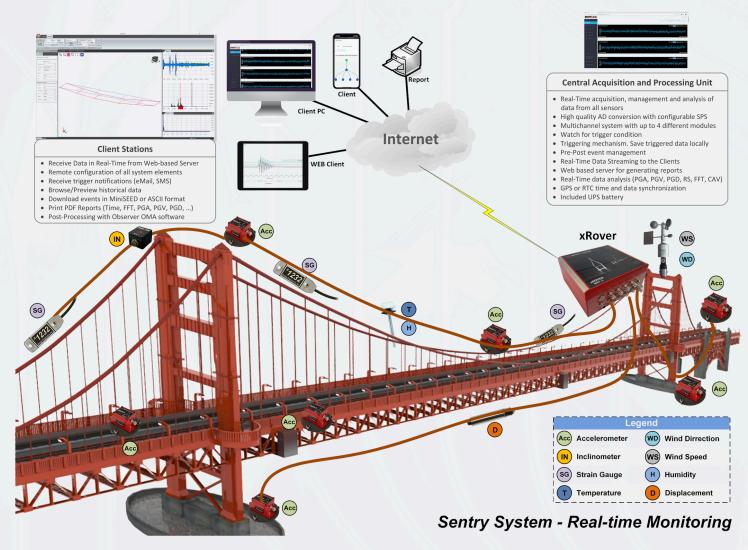

By concentrating multi-type sensor inputs into one modular unit (xRover) and managing them with Voyager® on xPlorer® or in the cloud, xCAS delivers synchronized, low-noise data, real-time streaming, automated reports, and event-driven alarms from a single, serviceable platform. It fits projects where cabinet-based wiring is preferred—plants, buildings, tunnels, dams—while scaling cleanly in channel count and functionality.

The system integrates seamlessly with Voyager® for centralized acquisition, storage, analysis, alarming, and publishing. Each cabinet digitizes signals at the source with 24/32-bit ADCs and applies GPS/DigiSync® timing for sub-ms alignment, then streams to client stations for live preview and reporting. Local Ring Buffer + Store&Forward® protects continuity during outages, and automated PDF reports keep stakeholders informed.
