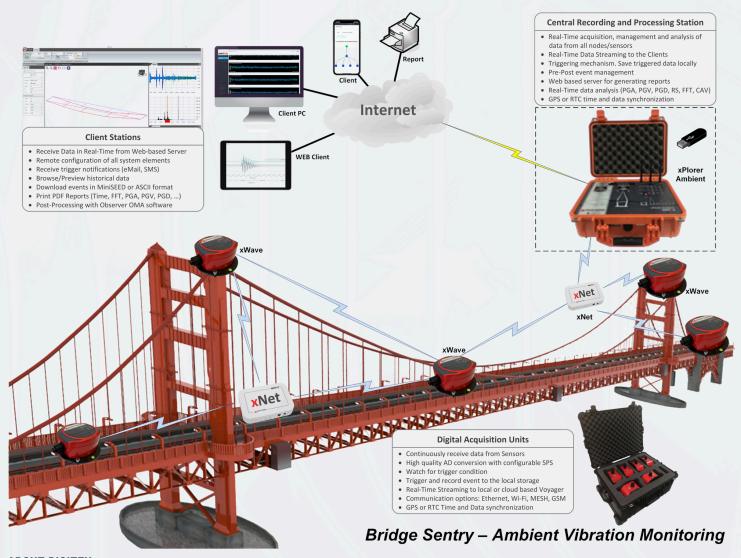

It combines battery-powered xWave® units with a portable xPlorer® running Voyager® to deliver synchronized, low-noise acceleration data, real-time viewing, automated PDF reports, and alerts—all deployable in hours for short-term surveys or rapid condition checks. Wireless links (or low-cost CAT5) and one-button field operation make it ideal for quick mobilization after events, construction impacts, or routine inspections.

The system streams data live to client stations (PC/tablet/phone), with up to ~24 h battery life per node, Ring Buffer + Store&Forward® continuity, and easy data export for OMA/FFT/PSD analysis. Weather-resistant enclosures and optional wireless coverage extension keep campaigns reliable in tough outdoor environments.

Measurements are fully digital, avoiding noise issues common with analog cabling. Units communicate via Ethernet, Wi-Fi, or DigiMESH®, enabling flexible setup in complex environments. The system is designed for autonomy, with rechargeable batteries powering all devices.
