# **OVERVIEW**

xPlorer® is Digitex Systems' rugged and powerful central acquisition unit, designed for permanent installation in Structural Health Monitoring (SHM) projects. It integrates hardware and software in one compact device, combining industrial-grade reliability with the full functionality of the Voyager® software suite for data collection, storage, synchronisation, processing, alarming, and reporting.

With its robust aluminum IP67 enclosure, integrated UPS battery, and advanced time synchronization modules, xPlorer ensures uninterrupted operation and precise alignment of data across large monitoring networks. Whether deployed on bridges, dams, tunnels, pipelines, or high-rise buildings, xPlorer is the backbone of SHM installations, enabling real-time decision-making and long-term performance insights.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

xPlorer acts as the central hub for all Sentry System devices (xWave, xSense, xStrain, etc.), supporting both local and remote configurations. It acquires and manages data from hundreds of channels simultaneously, with continuous Ring Buffer recording that ensures no event is missed. Data can be stored locally for up to 60 days and exported in proprietary compressed formats, MiniSEED, or ASCII for interoperability.

Equipped with dual Ethernet ports, DigiMESH® connectivity, and USB service access, xPlorer provides flexible integration options. One Ethernet port supports the sensor network, while the second offers optional LAN/Internet connectivity. Users may publish their xPlorer securely online through Digitex's tunneling service with predefined domains. Remote management is supported with over-the-air firmware updates, secure reboot, and configuration.

xPlorer includes a GPS module and Digitex's proprietary DigiSync® protocol, ensuring sub-millisecond accuracy in time and data synchronization across all connected devices – critical for advanced modal and vibration analysis. Even in GPS-denied environments, DigiSync maintains reliable synchronization, aligning every sensor with the central station clock.

Users can access data directly through a web browser, preview and analyze recordings, generate automated PDF reports, or stream live data to client applications. Optional alarming features include SMS and email notifications, relay outputs, and integration with third-party safety systems. The integrated UPS battery provides more than 20 hours of autonomy, ensuring continuous operation during power outages.
