Accelerometer Input: Three-channel modules with 20, 24 or 32 bit resolution for the connection of embedded or external accelerometers.

Geophone Input: Three-channel modules with 20, 24 or 32 bit resolution for the connection of embedded or external geophones.

Micro-Voltage Input: 4SDIFF/8DIFF/16SE 24-bit channel modules for the external connection of strain gauges, pressure sensors, and other appropriate transducers. The device provides 5V excitation. User-configurable gain (1 to 128) and measuring range (±39.06mV to ±5V)

Voltage Input: 8DIFF/16SE 16-bit channel modules for the external connection of displacement, temperature, humidity, corrosion, inclination sensors, and other appropriate transducers. Sensor powering can be done from the device. User-configurable measuring range (0-5V, 0-10V, ±5V, ±10V).

Weather Station Input: RS485 MODBUS input for the connection of weather stations that support this protocol. User-configurable reading channels (dependent on the weather station model—wind speed and direction, temperature, humidity, barometric pressure, solar radiation, precipitation, and more)



Embedded Accelerometer Options

D230-T: Ultra-sensitive accelerometer with 0.7 μ g/VHz noise in band. The sensor can measure up to ± 3 g with a dynamic range of 108.5 dB in the range of 0.1Hz to 100Hz. The noise, integrated over 0.1Hz to 100Hz, is 8 μ g. The bandwidth (± 3 dB) is 550Hz.

D225-T: High-sensitive accelerometer with 1 μ g/VHz noise in band. The sensor can measure up to ± 3 g in the frequency range of 0 to 200Hz. The zero-bias stability of the sensor is 0.03mg. It has a very low bias temperature coefficient of ± 0.2 mg/°C.

D220-T: Very-sensitive accelerometer with 7 μ g/VHz noise in band. The sensor can measure up to ± 2 g in the frequency range of 0 to 700Hz. Non-linearity, in the full range, is 0.1%. It has a very low bias temperature coefficient of ± 0.2 mg/°C.

D211-T/D212-T: Sensitive accelerometer with 22.5 μ g/VHz noise in band. User-configurable measuring range of ± 2 or ± 4 . Nonlinearity, in the full range, is 0.1%. It has a $\pm 0.01\%$ /°C sensitivity due to temperature.

Additional Embedded Sensor Options

Inclinometer: The device can be equipped with the embedded I230-B or I225-B inclinometer with an accuracy of $\pm 0.001^{\circ}$ in the preferred range (± 5 , ± 10 , $\pm 30^{\circ}$).

Geophone: With natural frequency of 4.5Hz, coil resistance of 375Ω and moving mass of 11.5g.

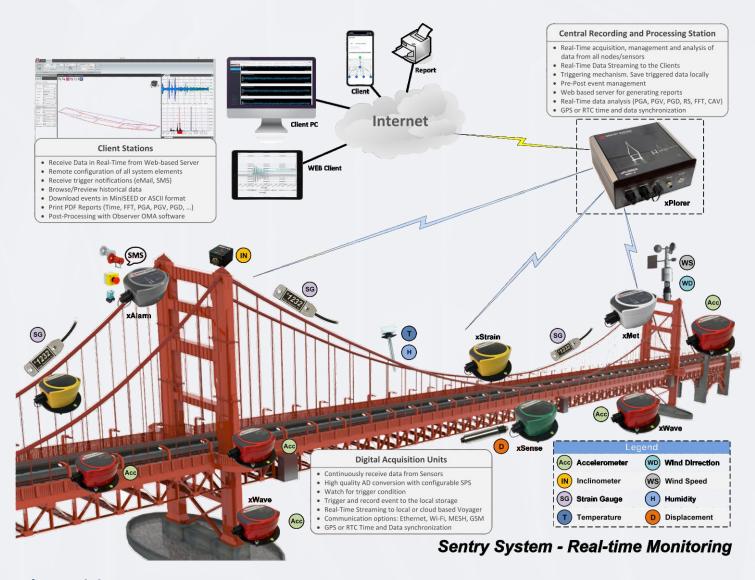


Real Time Monitoring System Architecture

The Digitex monitoring system is founded on a highly efficient, multithreaded software design. This design facilitates the acquisition of data from numerous xDAS units, the real-time monitoring and conditioning of this data, and its seamless distribution over the Internet to multiple remote locations.

Sensors embedded in the structure consistently transmit data to the system. In the event of occurrences such as earthquakes, predefined thresholds of drift are surpassed in one or multiple locations, prompting the recording and analysis of data, inclusive of preevent memory. Following the recording of an event, the system promptly notifies a specified list of users via email and uploads the event via FTP to an alternate site.

Leveraging the "quick analysis" feature of the Digitex system, various metrics pertaining to the monitored system's response can be disseminated to multiple locations and displayed in real time. The system possesses the capability to cross-correlate data, generating insightful information about the interaction between dynamic loads on the structure and its modal characteristics. This functionality enables a swift (preliminary) assessment of the predominant structural mode observed within the selected time window, serving as an estimator for the corresponding structural damping parameters.
